Enclosed are several pieces of correspondence regarding our efforts to get from the ATF information regarding its search for records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. Without repeating the details reflected in the enclosures, the ATF apparently has identified no records responsive to the JFK Act and has failed to provide us with any meaningful documentation of, or information regarding, its search for such records. Most recently, Robert Pritchett of the ATF has advised us to "contact the Department of the Treasury" for information on "initial searches" for ATF assassination records. Of course, you advised us to obtain such information directly from the ATF when we met in July 1995.

Any assistance or advice you can offer on these issues would be greatly appreciated. Thanks for your cooperation.
