Dear Mrs. Mohr, Dr. Mohr, and Mr. Scott:

Pursuant to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 ("JFK Act"), we are hereby serving upon each of you identical subpoenas seeking information and documents that you may have relating to records that either formerly were in the possession of Director J. Edgar Hoover or that relate to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, particularly those that were in the possession of Mr. John P. Mohr. We are not seeking any records that pertain solely to personal or financial matters involving Mr. Mohr. The exact scope of our request is specified at Attachment A of the subpoenas.

The subpoenas require you to come to the Assassination Records Review Board to offer testimony and to bring any responsive records with you. Please note that you will have to execute the attached Certificate of Compliance, which certifies that you have made a diligent search for the requested records. Although the date for you to come currently is set as August 11, 1997, we would be pleased to make alternative arrangements if that would be more convenient. You have the right, of course, to consult with an attorney regarding the subpoenas and to have an attorney present on August

11 (or alternative date if one is set).

The Review Board would like to make arrangements for review and questioning that will minimize any burden or inconvenience to Mrs. Mohr and other members of the Mohr family and we would be happy to provide transportation for you. Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions or suggestions that you may have regarding the subpoenas.

Unless I hear from you to the contrary, I will assume that the date of August 11 is satisfactory and that you will be bringing with you all responsive records.
