Dear Mr. Glassman:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter sent by the Assassination Records Review Board to Robert White and the other beneficiaries of the estate of Harold and Evelyn Lincoln. As Brian Rosen and David Montague of our staff discussed with you in a January 29, 1997 telephone conversation, the Review Board is attempting to contact Lincoln estate beneficiaries because we have reason to believe that the estate may have contained some records that would be useful for understanding issues related to the assassination of President Kennedy that were disbursed by the terms of the Lincolns' wills. We are particularly interested in meeting with Mr. White because he performed an inventory of the estate and, even if not in possession of assassination-related material himself, is in the best position to provide an overview of the contents of the estate and direct us to potential assassination records in the possession of other parties.

A member of our staff will telephone you again in the near future in order to attempt to arrange a meeting with Mr. White to discuss these issues. Please feel free to call me if you have any questions. We look forward to your cooperation.
