Dear Dr. Grossman:

I am writing you on behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, an independent Federal Agency established pursuant to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994). The Review Board, whose members are appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate, is charged with the responsibility of collecting records and information related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Review Board is not seeking to reach any conclusions regarding the assassination, and has no vested interest in either supporting or refuting the findings of the Warren Commission, the Rockefeller Commission, the Church Committee, or the House Select Committee on Assassinations; rather, we are primarily concerned with identifying, clarifying, locating, and making available assassination records. I am enclosing some explanatory material about the Review Board and its mandate.

It is our understanding that you were present in Trauma Room One at Parkland Hospital on November 22, 1963, during the resuscitative attempts on President Kennedy, and that you had an opportunity to observe President Kennedy's wounds. It is also our understanding that neither the Warren Commission nor the House Select Committee on Assassinations interviewed you about your observations on November 22, 1963. As part of our ongoing attempt to complete the record of President Kennedy's assassination, we would like to interview you in Houston (or some other convenient location). If you possess any contemporaneous personal records of the events of 11/22/63, such as personal journal or diary entries, or any memoranda you may have written which recorded your recollections of events at that time, we would be very interested in reviewing those records as well.

Some persons with whom we have spoken have requested that we issue subpoenas (which we are empowered to issue under Federal law). Although we generally prefer not doing so, we will be
