I am writing to advise you of the actions we are taking with respect to the materials you faxed me on October 23, 1995. I have given your fax and the Edwards-Rose letter to our Chief Analyst for Military Records, who will work with the Department of Defense to locate whatever records can be found regarding "The Geneva Diplomat." We will also pursue a similar inquiry through the Central Intelligence Agency.

Should any materials be found that are relevant to the assassination of President Kennedy, the Assassination Records Review Board will examine them in accordance with the provisions of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act for the purpose of releasing them to the JFK Collection in the National Archives.
