Dear Dr. Humes:

I am writing to thank you again for appearing for the deposition on February 13, 1996. I trust that you had a safe return to Florida. I want to thank you as well for bringing the documents you produced in response to the request in the subpoena. The travel claim you signed has been submitted, and your reimbursement check for travel expenses and per diem will be mailed to you as soon as your claim is processed. We will be forwarding the transcript to you upon receipt.

I am returning with this letter the original videotape (which has been copied), and the original documents you brought to the deposition, with two exceptions: namely, the onionskin copies (with signatures and/or marginalia in original ink) of the November, 1966 Inventory of Autopsy Photographs and X-Rays, and the January, 1967 Military Review Report which relates the autopsy photos and X-Rays to the autopsy protocol results from November, 1963. (I am enclosing photocopies of these two documents.) Because these two documents contain original notations and signatures, we would like to ask if you are willing to donate these to the JFK Collection at the National Archives. If this arrangement is not acceptable to you, please notify us promptly. We are referring the letter from Arlen Specter to you to his Senate office to determine whether he has any objections to its release.

Thank you again for your cooperation with the Review Board's ongoing attempt to identify, locate, gather, and clarify records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Should you have any questions or any matters you wish to discuss, please feel free to call.
