As we discussed, the Review Board is interested in obtaining information covered by the confidentiality provisions of the Internal Revenue Code concerning Lee Harvey Oswald. I hope that you have had an opportunity to consider our conversation and that you have decided to assist in our efforts to get the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to release these important records to the Review Board.

In order to obtain the IRS records on Mr. Oswald, the Review Board must provide the IRS with written consent from you, Mr. Oswald's next of kin. So that you will not need to find the consent form we sent to you in May, I am enclosing a letter to the IRS for your signature, along with a form entitled "Consent to Disclosure of Tax Information" for you to complete. I have placed red flags on the parts of the letter and the form that you will need to complete.

Once you have signed the letter and completed the form, please return them to us in the postage-paid return envelope enclosed with this letter.
