The Assassination Records Review Board was created by the Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107, which mandates the identification, disclosure, and preservation of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The Review Board has been tasked to review classified materials and to identify additional assassination records.
