The Review Board is not seeking to reach any conclusions regarding the assassination but is primarily concerned with identifying, clarifying, locating, and making available assassination records.

As a part of our work, we are attempting to collect records related to the assassination of President Kennedy that may be located in private hands. We have learned that some HSCA staffers and consultants have kept copies of records -- some of which are now otherwise unavailable. We are particularly interested in including any working papers, notes, recordings, data, or memoranda that you may have preserved from your work for the HSCA. One former HSCA Staff member, for example, sent us her copies of records that were no longer available from the relevant agency. These records are now an important part of the JFK Collection at the National Archives.
