Dear Mr. Golden:

I am writing in regard to NASA's compliance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 (Supp. V 1994) (JFK Act). Under the JFK Act, all Federal Government offices -- including NASA -- are required to search for and identify records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Assassination Records Review Board, a panel appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate, is responsible for overseeing governmental compliance with the JFK Act. A copy of the law and a publication describing the Review Board is enclosed.

In particular, we are interested in locating any records associated with the trajectory analysis study conducted by Dr. Thomas Canning in 1978. Dr. Canning was a Staff Engineer for the Space Projects Division at the NASA Ames Research Center at Moffet Field, California, who conducted this study at the request of the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA). While the records of the HSCA contain the draft report and various correspondence from Dr. Canning,<sup>1</sup> we are currently looking for additional material, including notes, memoranda, models, graphs and any other documents used by Dr. Canning to conduct his trajectory analysis. I have included copies of some of his correspondence in the hopes that this will assist in your search.

Additionally, I would appreciate it if you would identify those individuals who will be responsible for the process of searching for, identifying and reviewing assassination records. For your convenience,
