The Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) is an independent Federal agency created by the President John F. Kennedy Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. §2107 (Supp V 1994) to oversee the identification and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. In this regard, the ARRB is interested in identifying any additional records that may relate to the death of President Kennedy.

In the June 3, 1997 <u>Federal Register</u>, (Volume 62, Number 106, pages 30346-30347), there is notice from the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) regarding the requests of certain Federal agencies for records disposition authority. According to the announcement, the record schedules identify those records that warrant either retention at the National Archives or that may be destroyed. The June 3 notice identified one record schedule the ARRB would be interested in examining in order to determine if it is relevant to identifying any records that relate to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.
