Re: Request for Testimony Under The JFK Assassination Records Collection Act

Dear Dr. Clark:

Following up on our conversation today, I am writing to formally request that you consider testifying to the Assassination Records Review Board ("Review Board") regarding treatment of President Kennedy at Parkland Hospital on the day of the assassination.

The Assassination Records Review Board ("Review Board") was created as an independent federal agency under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, 44 U.S.C. § 2107 ("JFK Act"), to identify and release to the public records relating to the assassination of President Kennedy. The Review Board is composed of five distinguished members who were appointed by President Clinton in 1994. For your information, I am enclosing a copy of the JFK Act, as well as an informational pamphlet regarding the Review Board. The Review Board members specifically desire to obtain your testimony on the record. We have previously deposed certain of the medical personnel who participated in the autopsy of President Kennedy, and we wish to obtain the sworn testimony of some of the Parkland Hospital personnel who treated President Kennedy. We are presently arranging to take the testimony of Drs. McClelland, Peters, Perry, Jones, and Baxter on August 27th in Dallas. We believe your testimony would be valuable in completing the record in this area.

Accordingly, we would like to arrange a mutually convenient time to meet with you in Dallas, Pebble Beach, or Washington, D.C. Thank you for considering our request, and I will contact you to discuss this further.
