Re: Criminal Division/JFK Act

Dear Mr. Fogel:

In past communications, we had asked the Criminal Division to ascertain the identity and existence of an Oswald file referred to in prior correspondence between Robert L. Keuch of DOJ and the House Select Committee on Assassinations. It was not clear what file Mr. Keuch was discussing. As you know, FBI files on Oswald and DOJ files relating to the assassination are in the JFK Collection, and it is possible Mr. Keuch was referring to one of those.

We have spoken to Mr. Keuch, and I am enclosing a memorandum summarizing our telephone interview with him. I thought you should know that Mr. Keuch does not specifically recall any pre-assassination file on Oswald within DOJ. Accordingly, based on our conversation with Mr. Keuch, we have no present reason to believe that there is a separate Oswald file beyond the FBI and DOJ files identified under the JFK Act.
