SUBJECT: Pike Committee Assassination Records

On January 28, 1998, Peter Voth and I visited the offices of the House Intelligence Committee to inspect two boxes of original Pike Committee records. These records relate to the assassination of JFK and, in fact, are simply a duplicate set of the Pike Committee materials in the JFK Collection. We were not given access to any other Pike Committee holdings, and we were told by Bill McFarland, the Security Officer, that he does not know where the overall Pike Committee holdings are.

Peter and I identified the originals of the 20 documents that had been redacted and placed in the JFK Collection. The unredacted versions will be copied and sent to us. Thereafter, we can have the CIA team evaluate the appropriateness of the redactions and have the Review Board rule on them.
