- 2) State of Louisiana v. Walter Sheridan No. 199-944, filed sometime between July 7, 1967, and December 1, 1967. The records my colleague found indicate the case was filed in **Civil** District court although it appears to be a criminal case. - 3) State of Louisiana v. Rick (Richard) Townley Nos. 199-177, 199-978, and 199-979, all filed sometime before December 1967.
