By way of introduction, the Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) is an independent federal agency created to oversee the identification and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

The ARRB was established by the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (PL 102-526) and was signed into law by President George Bush. The law gives the ARRB the mandate and authority to identify, secure, and make available all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy.

The scope of the Review Board's mandate includes assassination-related records in the custody of federal agencies, local and state government entities, as well as those in the private sector.

It is our understanding that your office may have information relevant to the death of Mr. Charles Leslie Bronson. Based on procedures outlined by Maria of your office, we request that a search be completed for information about his death, using the period of May 1995 to the present. Any urgency which may be placed on this request is greatly appreciated. We have faxed this request to you in order to further expedite the process.
