Dear Mr. Doepfner:

I received a letter from Sergeant Louis Lombardi of the Police Department's Legal Unit, F.O.I.L. Unit today. Please find a copy of that letter enclosed.

I am concerned that the Review Board's first letter to the Police Department, dated July 28, 1995, was misrouted at some point to Sergeant Lombardi's office. The Review Board's July 31 request was not a Freedom of Information Act request; rather we are requesting records used by the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) during its investigation in 1978 of President Kennedy's assassination.

Please call me at ext. 229 if you have any questions about this matter or if I can clarify any aspects of our request. I am sending Sergeant Lombardi a copy of this letter as well. In the interest of clarity, I've enclosed copies of our July 28, August 31, and October 25, 1995 letters and copies of correspondence written in 1978 between HSCA Chief Counsel G. Robert Blakey and Police Commissioner Robert J. McGuire. I hope these records are useful in fulfilling our request.
