Thanks again for taking the time to send the ARRB the newspaper articles and book sections.

I understand your interest in papers or records that may mention your mother's name; and I know you understand that, as a government employee, I cannot conduct research or records searches on behalf of private individuals. I do want you to see how simple and efficient the records search process through the JFK Collection at the National Archives can be. In that regard, one of my colleagues ran a quick check in the House Select Committee on Assassinations database using your mother's name. We found three documents that in some way mention her name. I have requested another of my colleagues to get copies of those documents the next time he travels to Archives II in College Park, Maryland.
