Dear Mr. Evica:

I've recently read your testimony to the ARRB at its public hearing in Boston and was especially interested in your comments about the planning that occurred for the Dallas motorcade. I believe you noted that the HSCA made scant mention of this issue, as was the apparent case with the Warren Commission as well. You stated in your testimony that you've assembled some 200 pages of research on this issue.

In conjunction with several of my colleagues at that Review Board, I am seeking the records created during the planning of the Texas trip, especially in Dallas. I am seeking records from non-federal sources (Dallas Police Department, Dallas County Sheriff's Department, etc.) while my colleagues are looking for the federal agency records (Secret Service, FBI, etc.).

I would like to speak with you by telephone soon and would very much appreciate it if you would consider sharing your research with the Review Board to the extent that it will assist us in locating assassination records. I will call you in the next few days. Thank you in advance for your anticipated further cooperation with the Review Board's important work.
