This letter is to follow up on our meeting on May 15 and telephone conversation on June 5, 1995, at which time we discussed the photographs of Lee Harvey Oswald, David Ferrie, and related Civil Air Patrol and New Orleans activities which you have in your files at home. I understand from you that you obtained these photos (which date from the 1950s) through your work as a New Orleans police officer assigned to the Intelligence Division in the 1960s.

I know you are very involved with your business, which, as you mentioned, requires frequent travel. The Review Board would appreciate it, however, if you could make a concerted effort to locate these photos in order that we can arrange to obtain copies of them.

Thank you for your time and continuing cooperation with the Review Board's Congressionally mandated search for all assassination-related records. I will be in contact with you in the near future to follow up on this request.
