This letter will confirm our telephone conversation this morning concerning the Review Board's request for the personnel records of the Commission on CIA Activities Within the United States, commonly referred to as the Rockefeller Commission. As I explained this morning, these records will be used by the Review Board to fulfill its Congressionally mandated responsibility to locate all assassination records created by former federal government investigations of President Kennedy's assassination for transmittal to the John F. Kennedy Records Collections.

I understand you will need to confer with Ms. Holzhauzen and review the records to determine what the Ford Library has in its holdings that will be responsive to the Review Board's request. I look forward to speaking with you again when you make this determination.
