Dear Mr. Shinley:

By way of introduction, I am the Review Board's Chief Investigator. In part, my duties include searching for assassination records from non-federal sources. This includes private individuals and organizations, as well as state, county, and local government entities. My work in that regard is often aided by researchers, such as yourself, who write with suggestions about where the ARRB should be looking for assassination-related records from federal and, for my part, from non-federal sources.

I reviewed your letter of February 27, 1995, for your references to the Dallas Police Department's investigation of Joe R. Molina and will include this in my work with the Dallas Police. Our Research and Analysis (R&A) component, which focuses on federal sources of records, will explore the federal aspects of the Molina and Bill Lowery records.

I've also made note of your suggestion concerning Russell Wence McLarry. Although I cannot report on the status of our records releases until they actually occur, I can tell you that the Secret Service is currently reviewing McLarry's file; we anticipate it will be released by the Secret Service by next spring (1996).
