Investigative - Anne

* Met with David, Dave and Tom to plan the Board's approach to finding photographic and film records in Dallas and attendant publicity of the Board's initiative.

* Opened an investigative issue, 7.1.58, Locate and Interview Frank Ragano. He is currently living in Tampa, Florida. Jeremy asked me to interview him on an upcoming trip to Florida.

* Opened an investigative issue, 7.1.59, JFK Skull X-ray, Dr. Poppen and Dr. Neumann. Robert Vernon sent David a fax about the possibility that Dr. Neumann has an x-ray taken at JFK's autopsy and given to Dr. Poppen on November 22 or 23, 1963 at Bethesda Naval Hospital. (Dr. Poppen allegedly flew there at Jacqueline Kennedy's request to view the autopsy.)

* Opened an investigative issue, 7.1.62, Charles Bronson Assassination Film, based on Richard Trask's comments to Dave the Bronson recently died and his family may be willing to donate the film to the JFK Collection.

* I've worked continuously all week to arrange interview appointments for my upcoming trip to New Orleans, Baton Rouge and Miami. I'm also actively planning and arranging interviews for my trip in mid-October to Tampa, St. Louis and Chicago.

* Dave and I met with Dennis and Doug to discuss an initial investigative strategy concerning the "petition" recently filed with the Board by members of the medical research community.

Investigative - Dave

* Conducted telephone interview with Richard Trask concerning Dealey Plaza witnesses. This is part of the planning and investigation of photo and film sources for the upcoming work in Dallas.

* Contacted Bettman Archives in New York City based on information from Richard Trask that they

have a lot of old UPI films, and in the hope they may have the original Nix film and other assassination related UPI films.

* Met with Tom concerning media organizations in Dallas.

* Met with Eric concerning the Library of Congress collection of assassination related audio and video tapes from CBS and other networks.
