I was happy that members of my staff and I could "tag along." It was a tremendous opportunity for the students to hear directly from you and discuss their recent experiences with the Review Board.

I would also like to thank you for offering your assistance to ensure that the Review Board is extended for an additional year, until September 30, 1998. The additional time will allow the Review Board to review and release to the American public important records related to the assassination of President Kennedy that remain in the files of the CIA and the FBI. If we are fortunate enough to be allowed one more year of operation, the Board will be able to come to a confident conclusion of its important task and submit a more complete final report to the Congress.
