Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (JFK Act), I am writing to inform you that the Assassination Records Review Board has made additional formal determinations on August 3, 1995, concerning the public disclosure of executive branch records.

Enclosed is a list of the determinations that the Review Board has made. These decisions were premised on several factors including the significant historical interest in the documents, the sources and methods involved in the collection of material, and the names of Central Intelligence Agency officers. The Review Board has recommended that some information continue to be postponed.

Under the JFK Act you are provided 30 days to make a final decision with respect to disclosure of these records. You are invited to send your representative to the Review Board to examine our copies of the documents for which determinations have been made and to discuss the determinations with my staff.
