The Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) is an independent Federal Agency within the Executive Branch, established by Congress under the *President John F. Kennedy Records Collection Act of 1992*, 44 USC 2107 (the "Act"). Section 10(b)(2) of the Act indicates that foreign governments should be contacted in an effort to locate all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy.

Pursuant to the wishes of Congress, the ARRB is currently planning a trip to Belarus and Russia to meet with relevant officials to discuss access to important records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The ARRB delegation for this first of several possible foreign trips is as follows:
