As we discussed on the telephone, the Assassination Records Review Board (ARRB) is currently undertaking a review of the medical evidence of the assassination of President Kennedy. In this connection, we believe it would be prudent to secure the assistance of a forensic anthropologist who could help us understand and interpret the evidence.

We would be most pleased if you would agree to assist us. We make this request cognizant of your experience and reputation as a recognized expert in your field. In addition, we understand that you have made no public comment on the assassination.

I am enclosing information about the ARRB, including a copy of our enabling legislation. As a first step, perhaps it would be useful to have a short meeting with you to discuss the scope of our undertaking and address any questions you might have. Please call me so that we can set up a time.
