This is in response to your letter of December 4, 1995, regarding obtaining additional records released by the Board.

Per your request, I am enclosing a set of records released by the Board on November 21, 1995. These are documents which the Board voted to release at their September 1995 meeting. Because the number of records being voted on by the Board increased dramatically after the September meeting, all documents released subsequent to this meeting will have to be obtained from the National Archives. We provided released documents directly to interested parties, as a courtesy, for as long as the number of documents was reasonable and within our staff capabilities.

The Review Board and staff will not be able to respond to legal questions relative to documents which are released. The Board's mandate is to review assassination records, compile as complete a record of the assassination as possible, and make that record available to the American public.

Thank you for your continuing interest in the work of the Review Board.
