## JFK ASSASSINATION RECORDS REVIEW BOARD TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING IN LOS ANGELES, TOMORROW, TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17TH AT 10:00 A.M.

The Assassination Records Review Board, an independent federal agency overseeing the review and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, will hold a public hearing in **Los Angeles** on **Tuesday, September 17, 1996**.

The hearing will be held in the Los Angeles Board of Education Hearing Room which is Room H-160, located on the first floor of the Hill Street Building in the building complex at 450 North Grand Avenue. The Board will hear a wide range of expert testimony on the identification and location of assassination records. Review Board members will be available to the media for interviews at 9:30 a.m. in the Board of Education Hearing Room.
