This in response to your April 12, 1996 letter regarding several documents that were referred to other agencies for review. As indicated to you by the National Archives staff, these documents are still in the "referred" status. If these documents still have redactions after they have been reviewed by the relevant agencies, the Review Board will then make independent determinations, as it does with all such assassination records, on whether or not any information should be postponed. I cannot predict when such a review would occur. If the relevant agencies reviewing the documents do not want to postpone the release of any information then the documents will be sent directly to the National Archives.
