## **COMMENTS:**

For your additional information, I am faxing "before" and "after" versions of two FBI documents that the Review Board has released. These document graphically demonstrate how the Board is opening up documents previously unavailable to the public.

The first document, dated December 1, 1966, was recently released by the Board. I have attached pages 1-3 of the "before" document (pages 2 and 3 heavily redacted) and pages 2 and 3 of the "after" version (page 1 did not have any redactions). As you will see in paragraph 2 of page 3, this document has to do with an FBI informant allegedly stating that the KGB had information that President Johnson was involved in the assassination of President Kennedy. The information was kept closed (since 1966) until the Board released it.

The second document, dated October 12, 1960 was much sought after by historians because it dealt with the FBI tracking Oswald three years before the assassination. The Review Board aggressively pursued this document. After months of resistance by the FBI, the Board finally got it released.

We hope this additional material is helpful.
