Per our conversation about the Lopez Report, I have attached "before and after" versions of pages 33, 61, and 81. As you can see, the Board has opened technical intelligence gathering information that leaves no doubt about how closely the Soviet and Cuban embassies were watched by the CIA. Prior to the new release by the Board of the Lopez Report and other CIA documents that contained similar information, these secrets were closely guarded by the Agency.

In addition to the details that are provided by the information opened up by the Review Board, the new information is important because there no longer needs to be speculation about what is redacted; it is now there in black and white for all to read.

I hope these examples help.
