As I know you are aware, the Assassination Records Review Board is an independent federal agency created by The President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 (PL 102-526) to oversee the review and release of records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. I would like to take this opportunity to raise a matter regarding materials that you have donated to the John Fitzgerald Kennedy Library.

In March 1995, with your prior permission through the Library staff, the members of the Review Board examined your undeed papers that relate to William Manchester's book <u>Death of a President</u> and four pages of diary entries that you wrote after the assassination that are deeded, but closed. A Board staff member recently reviewed the materials again at the Library.

The Review Board would like to request that you authorize the release of these materials. It is the Board's belief that their public release would enrich the historical record surrounding the assassination.
