Dear Tom:

Thank you for your letter dated August 15, 1997 regarding the film and other matters that was received by fax in the Review Board offices on August 16, 1997.

I believe that we are in agreement about the historical importance of the film and that it should be available now to the American public for non-commercial use. To make the film available at this time, while also protecting your copyright interests, I suggest that we proceed with a Deed of Gift. At a later time, any additional material and information that you have compiled could supplement the existing film and be made part of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives.

I have enclosed the necessary materials to begin the Deed of Gift process. Please find two signed originals and one photocopy of the Deed of Gift for the film. Please sign both originals and return them to our office in the enclosed envelope. We will return to you one of the signed originals after we receive all signatures. You may keep the photocopy for your records.

Please carefully review the Deed of Gift before you sign and do not hesitate to call if you have any questions or concerns.

Again, thank you for your most recent letter. The Review Board appreciates your willingness to continue this dialogue which we hope will result in a donation that will enrich the history surrounding the assassination of President Kennedy.
