This letter is in response to your letters of March 30, April 1 (3 letters), April 3, April 4, April 13, and April 14, 1998.

The database at the Archives is being updated, but in the meantime, you are accessing information that can be outdated. I am happy to report that all but three documents mentioned in your letters have in fact been released in full. Document numbers 180-10085-10125 (Robert McKeown), 180-10085-10255 (William Sullivan), 180-10108-10234 (Oswald activities Nov. 22-24), and 180-10080-10166 (Otto Otepka) are all open in full.

In addition, I have done a check in our database for all documents related to Carl Mather, and they, too, appear to be open. I have enclosed these record identification forms.

Document number 180-10081-10360 (photostatic copy of Oswald's W-4 form) was referred to the IRS by the HSCA. We have looked into this issue. Tax return information is possibly protected by section 6103 of the IRS code, and is exempt from the JFK Act as stipulated in section 11(a). Please be assured, however, that the Review Board is working with the IRS to release the W-4 form and other Oswald tax information.

I have forwarded the information you provided about the other two documents to members of the staff. We are reviewing your inquiry about Oswald's Marine Corps training station classbook and the HSCA document regarding James Wilcott.

I hope this information is helpful to you.
