I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for speaking with me on the telephone earlier this week about the Review Board's efforts to ensure that the historical record surrounding the assassination of President John F. Kennedy is as complete as possible. I appreciate your taking time out of your busy schedule to assist the Board.

Per our conversation, we checked our data base to determine whether or not your acoustical evidence analysis was ever made a part of the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection (JFK Collection) at the National Archives. We were pleased to find that a copy of your manuscript was apparently in the FBI files and is already a part of the JFK Collection. I have enclosed a copy of the Record Information Form that accompanies the document in the Collection.
