I have attached recent correspondence from the office of Congressman Goodlatte on behalf of one of his constituents, Don Kotchish. David was wondering if you could weigh in on this.

Mr. Kotchish initially contacted Congressman Goodlatte after seeing an AP article about the Board's April 24, 1997 resolution regarding the status and disposition of the Zapruder film. He would like to know the cost of the film and why the appraised value is "a secret."

We responded by enclosing a copy of the Board's resolution. Congressman Goodlatte's office has contacted us again and stated that his constituent's questions were not fully answered.

Mr. Kotchish would like to know:

- 1) how much will American citizens pay for the preservation of the film (and how is it or will it be determined?)
- 2) Is any of this matter being kept secret?
