Brief summary of statement by Robert Griel Vinson

Mr. Vinson was formerly in the military. On November 21, 1963 he met with a Col. Chapman at the Pentagon to discuss his promotion. While in Chapman's office, Vinson claims to have heard Chapman on the phone with someone and highly recommending that the President not go to Dallas.

He states that on November 22, 1963, he was on a military plane from Andrews AFB to Lowrey AFB in Denver, and that the plane stopped in Dallas, picked up two men, and then went on to Roswell, where he and everyone else on the plane deboarded.

Vinson claims that one of the two men who boarded the plane in Dallas strongly resembled Oswald.
