The staff of the Senate Subcommittee on Treasury and General Government of the Committee on Appropriations has requested a letter from the Assassination Records Review Board stating that the Board is exempt from The Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) and is not required to submit a strategic plan under the Act. We have been verbally advised by Mr. Walter Groszyk, of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), that a determination has been made by OMB that the Review Board is exempt because the agency will cease to exist by Fiscal Year 1999, the first year for which a strategic plan is required.

Please consider this a request for a letter from OMB to me stating that the Review Board is exempt from the GPRA and does not have to submit a strategic plan. We will then share this letter with the Subcommittee staff.
