Per our telephone conversation today, I am writing to you to reiterate the objective of our possible meeting. The Review Board staff will meet with you for approximately 2-3 hours to hear your presentation about the materials that you have in your possession that relate to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

As you know, the Review Board was established by the John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992. The Review Board was mandated to oversee the identification and release of all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy. The work of the Review Board does not constitute an investigation into the assassination.

The Review Board will "sunset" on September 30, 1998. Due to this late date, neither the details of your presentation nor your materials will be included in our final report. However, we will audiotape your presentation and provide you with a copy. The original audiocassette, along with any materials that you give to the Review Board, will become a part of the permanent JFK Collection at the National Archives.
