

Investigative Update for Week Ending July 28, 1995

Investigative

* Spent Tuesday at Archives II reviewing Secret Service and Naval Medical Service files on autopsy looking for information about x-rays and photographs.

* Spent all day Wednesday locating Leodis C. Matthews, former HSCA staff counsel. By the middle of the afternoon I spoke with Matthews by telephone and learned that he and his assistant, Eileen Dinneen, reviewed Secret Service Protective files at Secret Service offices.

* In conjunction with Joan Zimmerman, prepared an affidavit for Matthews to sign relevant to his work reviewing Secret Service records for the HSCA.

* Began work to locate Eileen Dinneen. By 8:45 am Thursday morning I located her in Colleyville, Texas. After two telephone interviews with her on Thursday she refused to provide any of the numerous handwritten notes she made during her HSCA work as a paralegal, including her review of Secret Service records in early 1978. Pursued additional steps to secure her records.

* Conducted telephone interview of researcher George Michael Evica to learn more about his statement to the Review Board at the Boston public hearing that he has 200 pages of research on the planning for the Dallas motorcade.

* Reviewed several classified documents that have been waiting for my review. These documents pertain to ongoing investigative issues. These investigations may now continue.

* Submitted 58 names to FINCEN this week to begin locate process of former investigative committee members. Held telephone conference with Alex Treadaway, case development officer at FINCEN, to establish their administrative criteria for this and future large requests.

* Attended security clearance briefing at DOJ.

* Maintained contact with David Montague on his security clearance and entry on duty date.
