Notice of Vote to Close Meeting

By majority vote on January 5, 1995, the members of the Assassination Records Review Board determined that its board meeting scheduled for January 25, 1995 shall be closed to the public. Board members voting to close the meeting were: John Tunheim, Kermit Hall, William Joyce, and Anna Nelson. Henry Graff did not participate in the vote as he was out of the country.

The Board's vote to close the January 25 meeting to the public was based on the expectation that the Board will at that meeting review postponed records that were created by or in the possession of the Warren Commission and the House Select Committee on Assassinations. The records expected to be reviewed and discussed at this meeting include material that has been postponed on grounds that its release could potentially cause an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy that outweighs the public interest in its disclosure.
