For your information and at Don Goldberg's suggestion, accompanying this cover sheet is an advance copy of the Assassination Records Review Board's proposed interpretive regulations, which will be made public this week. These regulations are intended to provide guidance for the interpretation of certain terms in the Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992, including the scope of the term "assassination record." The proposed regulations also provide guidance for the implementation of other provisions of the Act.

These proposed regulations will be published tomorrow (February 8) in the Federal Register and are available for inspection in the Federal Register reading room today. The Board has requested public comment on these proposed interpretive regulations and set a 30 day comment period (which will end at close of business, March 10).
