FYI, attached is a State Department memorandum to David from October that I've just come across and that we'll need to deal with sooner or later. Per the cover memo, the State Department is bringing to our attention certain documents that the State Department believes should be included in the collection at NARA but that, when referred to FBI, the FBI refused to review on grounds they believed them "not related" to the assassination. This is directly relevant to our proposed interpretive guidance and to how FBI in particular may have done its search and review of its own records. I'd like to discuss how best to deal with this in a coordinated way. Thanks!
