

FOIA followup issues
Notes

November 29, 1994:

Call from Richard Brown, DoJ FedPrograms Branch -- gave partial list of JFK files-related litigation (see file folder); said was likely he or Elizabeth Pugh would know about JFK related FOIA cases; agreed to send e-mail to all attys in branch to request names of additional cases anyway; will discuss with Elizabeth whether they can send a notice to US attorneys offices.

- Need to contact FOIA offices in target agencies to get lists of pending FOIA cases.
 - What have they identified and transferred/
 - What might still be left?
 - What to do about requests filed after act passed
 - Do we adjust effective date to that of technical amendments for expedition purposes

Act's provisions:

Section 5(2)(b)(G) requires agencies to give priority to identifying, reviewing, and transmitting, under the Act's postponement standards, assassination records that on the date of enactment of the Act are the subject of litigation under the FOIA. Intent to get rid of cases.[Were any cases filed after the act was passed? Intent to address these as a priority. [no mention of pending FOIA requests?]
