Conversation with Laura Naide, NARA RE her conversation with Justice on Zapruder film

- 1. She has drafted a memo that she will send us as soon as it's in final form.
- 2. Re takings: There's no taking until the government says its an assassination record. Any takings claim the Zapruders would file now likely would be dismissed as not ripe
- 3. The government can but is not required to negotiate on a takings claim with the Zapruders. There is no requirement that administrative remedies be exhausted here.
- 4. A takings claim would be litigated in Claims Court.
- 5. The Justice Department thinks there's no advantage to the government in a takings claim situation to entering into a copyright settlement.
