The National Security File (NSF) Finding Aid is divided into seven computer files.

- 1 "COUNTRY" Country File All countries except Vietnam
- 2 "VIETNAM.NSF" Country File- Vietnam
- 3-5 "OTHER1.NSF", "OTHER2.NSF", "OTHER3.NSF"

These files each contain a folder title list for number of the smaller file series found within the National Security File. To see exactly which ones are in a given file $List\ Files$ (F5 enter), use the arrow keys to highlight the "other" file of your choice, then press 6 or L. This will show you the document summary, which lists all the parts of the NSF within that file. Not all files have document summaries. If you follow the above procedure for a file without a summary, WordPerfect lets you view the text of the document without retrieving it. From this screen you can Search the document.

- 6 "DSDUF.FTL"- stands for Declassified and Sanitized Documents from Unprocessed Files. Much of this file is Vietnam related, but since it is really only a temporary holding area that may change.
- 7 "NSFINTRO"- The Introductory Text. The NOTE about Staff Files is now outdated. The appendices included in the paper version of the NSF are not in the computer version.
