Files of Edward K. Hamilton

1964-1968

Edward K. Hamilton was a member of the NSC staff from September 1965 to December 1968. He came to the NSC from the Bureau of the Budget. During late 1965 and the first several months of 1966, he served as a junior staff officer under Francis M. Bator, who was Deputy Special Assistant to the President and Senior NSC Staff Member responsible for Europe and foreign economic policy.

By August 1966, Hamilton had become a Senior NSC Staff Member responsible for sub-Sahara Africa, a responsibility previously handled by William H. Brubeck (1963-64) and Ulric Haynes, Jr. (1965-66). Hamilton also continued into the summer of 1967 to devote roughly half his time to assisting Francis Bator with Europe and foreign economic policy.

Upon the departure in July 1967 of W. Howard Wriggins, who had handled South Asia for the NSC since 1966, Hamilton took over responsibility for South Asia while continuing to oversee sub-Sahara Africa. As a consequence of his new responsibilities and Francis Bator's departure in September 1967 (Edward Fried assumed most of Bator's responsibilities), Hamilton no longer worked either on Europe or foreign economic policy, except for foreign aid, which had been a significant responsibility of his since joining the NSC staff in 1965.

Hamilton continued to handle South Asia, sub-Sahara Africa, and foreign aid from the fall of 1967 until his departure in December 1968. Roger Morris of the NSC staff assisted him.

Boxes 1-4: Africa and South Asia

In addition to Hamilton's own material on Africa and South Asia, this series includes material on Africa generated by Hamilton's two predecessors in handling sub-Sahara Africa, William Brubeck (1963-64) and Ulric Haynes, Jr. (1965-66), and by Hamilton's staff assistant from September 1967 through much of 1968, Roger Morris. Also included in this series are Hamilton's files on Bulgaria, Lithuania, Japan, and the Asian Development Bank.

NATIONAL SECURITY FILE

FILES OF ROBERT W. KOMER (March 1966 - May 1967)

These files reflect Robert Komer's responsibilities as interim national security adviser during March 1966 and as Special Assistant to the President in charge of pacification and other U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam from late March 1966 until May 1967. On May 1, 1967, Komer left Washington for Saigon to become General Westmoreland's Deputy for Civil Operations and Revolutionary Development Support (CORDS). No material was added to these files after May 1967.

Komer as interim national security adviser, March 1966:

Robert Komer served as interim national security adviser following the departure of McGeorge Bundy on February 28, 1966, until Walt Rostow took over the reins of national security adviser on April 1, 1966.

Material reflecting this role is found mainly in Box 1, both in the Chron File for March 1966 and in the files on "India" and "NATO." Additional material can be found in the Chron Files for March 1966 in Boxes 2 and 3 and in "Memos for the Record (1)," Box 3.

Komer as Special Assistant to the President in charge of U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam, March 1966 -- May 1967:

In National Security Action Memorandum No. 343, dated March 28, 1966, President Lyndon Johnson charged Special Assistant Robert Komer and Komer's deputy, Ambassador William Leonhart, with responsibility for the "direction, coordination and supervision in Washington of U.S. non-military programs for peaceful construction relating to Vietnam." William Leonhart later stated that it was the President's determination that such programs "be speeded up, given priority with military operations, and conducted with wartime urgency."

Boxes 2 through 9 of the Files of Robert W. Komer consist almost entirely of material created in the discharge of this responsibility, with the exception of a small number of documents dealing with U.S. policy in South Asia, the Middle East, and elsewhere that are found mainly in Boxes 2 and 3. Researchers interested in Komer's role as Special Assistant in charge of U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam should also consult the Komer-Leonhart File. See the "Note" below.

The responsibilities of Komer's White House office for U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam included a broad range of issues, such as pacification, land reform, Chieu Hoi (a program for encouraging Viet Cong defections), economic stabilization and control of inflation, rice production, port congestion, corruption, and postwar planning.

By November 1966 the office consisted of Komer as head; William Leonhart, Komer's deputy; Richard Holbrooke, assistant to Komer; Colonel Robert Montague, military adviser; Peter Rosenblatt, assistant to William Leonhart; Richard Moorsteen, economist; five secretaries; and a file clerk.

NOTE: Researchers interested in Komer's role as Special Assistant in charge of U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam should also consult the extensive Komer-Leonhart File. Consisting exclusively of material on U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam, the Komer-Leonhart File was initially created by Komer and his staff, and then, following Komer's departure for Vietnam in May 1967, was used for filing documents by Komer's successor, William Leonhart, and his staff during the next year and a half.

Some of the subject files in Boxes 6-9 of the Files of Robert W. Komer ("Corruption," "Economic Stabilization," "Port," "Psywar," "Rice") complement subject files in the Komer-Leonhart File, and, in a few instances, may have originally been part of the Komer-Leonhart File.

All the folders in the twenty-five boxes of the Komer Leonhart File have been processed, and the unclassified and declassified portions have been opened for research. Declassification review of the classified material may be requested under the Library's mandatory review program.

Komer-Leonhart File (1966-1968)

In National Security Action Memorandum No. 343, dated March 28, 1966, President Lyndon Johnson charged Special Assistant Robert W. Komer and Komer's deputy, Ambassador William Leonhart, with responsibility for the "direction, coordination and supervision in Washington of U.S. non-military programs for peaceful construction relating to Vietnam." William Leonhart later stated that it was the President's determination that such programs "be speeded up, given priority with military operations, and conducted with wartime urgency."

The Komer-Leonhart File, an alphabetically-arranged subject file containing material dated 1966-1968, reflects the operation of the White House office created by NSAM 343. The file should be consulted in conjunction with the Files of Robert W. Komer, which reflect the operation of this office during the period that Komer headed it, March 1966-May 1967.

The responsibilities of the office included a broad range of U.S. non-military programs in Vietnam, involving such issues as pacification, land reform, Chieu Hoi (a program for encouraging Viet Cong defections), economic stabilization and control of inflation, rice production, port congestion, corruption, and postwar planning.

By November 1966 the office consisted of Robert Komer, Special Assistant to the President; William Leonhart, Komer's deputy; Richard Holbrooke, assistant to Robert Komer; Colonel Robert Montague, military adviser; Peter Rosenblatt, assistant to William Leonhart; Richard Moorsteen, economist; five secretaries; and a file clerk.

On May 1, 1967, Robert Komer left Washington for Saigon to become General Westmoreland's Deputy for Civil Operations and Revolutionary Development Support (CORDS). On May 11, 1967, President Johnson named William Leonhart as Special Assistant to succeed Komer as head of the White House office for U.S. non military programs in Vietnam. Leonhart's deputies during 1967 and 1968 included Vincent Heyman and David Cuthell.

On September 14, 1967, William Leonhart recommended to President Johnson that he abolish the office "as a separate White House staff" and that its pacification functions be integrated with Walt W. Rostow's "Vietnam staff section." However, the office remained in operation during 1968 with Leonhart as head.

When William Leonhart submitted his letter of resignation to President Johnson on January 8, 1969, near the close of the Johnson presidency, he noted the following:

"in the first year of this inter-agency staff, there was established a unified direction of Vietnam non military operations and the first fully integrated civil-military field organization in our nation's history.

In the second year, a unified civil-military pacification concept was further elaborated. . . And the process of transferring pacification support to the departments and agencies responsible for its funding was begun. Today, every pacification program element developed since 1966 is lodged in the department or agency with primary funding accountability."

Some folders in the Komer-Leonhart File include material generated exclusively during Komer's tenure as head of the office, other folders have material only from Leonhart's period as head, and some folders were started under Komer but also used under Leonhart.

All the folders in the twenty-five boxes have been processed, and the unclassified and declassified portions have been opened for research. Declassification review of the classified material may be requested under the Library's mandatory review program.
