## VICE-PRESIDENTIAL SECURITY FILE

The Vice-Presidential Security File, 6'4", consists largely of the files on Colonel Howard L. Burris, who served as Air Force Aide to the Vice-President following his appointment on ebruary 25, 1961. Burris' responsibilities included national security matters, contacts with the military, and foreign and domestic travel. Burris continued as a Johnson aide until his retirement from the military in mid-1964.

Of special interest are the handwritten notes, with transcriptions, taken under NATIONS AND REGIONS, "Policy Papers and Background Studies on Cuba Affair (V)."
