Dear Mr. Custer:

Enclosed are your travel advance check, your airline tickets, and a letter from Tracy Shycoff of our staff that explains travel claim procedures and provides details regarding your hotel reservation. (Our travel claim procedures are simpler than they may appear at first, and we can answer any questions you may have following the deposition.)

I will meet you at the gate at National Airport when your flight arrives at approximately 5:02 P.M. on Monday, October 27, 1997, and I'll accompany you to your hotel and make sure you get checked in that evening. (Don't worry---I will recognize you at the gate, since I have seen you on video.) On Tuesday, October 28, I will meet you in the hotel lobby at about 8:00 A.M.; we will take the Metro (the Washington D.C. subway) together to the old National Archives building in downtown Washington, and we will then ride an Archives shuttle bus to the new Archives facility called "Archives II" in College Park, Maryland. The shuttle bus will arrive at the Archives at about 9:45, and the deposition will start shortly thereafter at 10:00. Following the deposition I will accompany you to National Airport via shuttle bus and Metro, and I'll see you to the gate of your departing flight.

Please ensure that you bring with you to the deposition any articles you may have written on the assassination, any government records you may have concerning the assassination, any audiotapes or videotapes you may have of interviews you have given (with the exception of commercially available tapes, which you are not required to bring with you), and any other records related to the assassination (such as diary or journal entries) you may have, as defined in your subpoena.

I want to thank you again for your cooperation these past few weeks. I look forward to meeting you and listening to your recollections about the events of November 1963 in which you participated. Your assistance in helping the Review Board better complete the historical record of events at President Kennedy's autopsy is appreciated.
